Wednesday 30th April 2014

On Wednesday 30th April our last session of both of the beginners' courses will be held on the main club field. Please respect that this evening will be their last session, so there will be no shooting for club members on this evening. The small field will be available for your use. From Wednesday the 7th May club night will continue for all club members on the main and smaller field. However, in order that the new members can concentrate on their improver's distance course there will be restrictions in place. Members will shoot to a maximum distance of 60 yards; this will cut down on the time collecting/looking for lost arrows etc. For those of you that wish to shoot longer distances the smaller field will be available.

Redruth Archers Tournaments

It is club policy that if you enter one of the clubs tournaments you should help out at the work parties leading up to the tournament

Up coming 720 Tournament – 11 May your help will be needed for the following:

- 6 & 8 May work parties
- 10 May 10.00 am to put the marquee up.
- A field crew will be required throughout the day of the tournament.
- Catering staff will be needed in the kitchen
- Donations for the catering would be a great help towards raising club funds, such cakes, pastries etc.
- Donations also required for the raffle.

The same procedure for help at the tournaments, work parties, donations for catering and raffle prizes will apply for the Double American and Double FITA Tournaments.

Alterations to your club membership have been made at the EGM held on the 8th April as follows:

It had been proposed by the Management Committee in the EGM calling-notice that shooting/target fees be included in annual membership fees with effect from 1^{st} October 2014. This would be at a rate of £12 for the year for Seniors (£6 per year for Juniors) and would cover all outdoor shooting fees. NOTE – this does <u>not</u> cover the cost of hiring equipment.

A general discussion was held about the merits and drawbacks of this proposal. Written representations from one member (who was unable to attend) were read out.

Also proposed (as a result of the debate that had taken place) by Robert Gillatt and seconded by Virginia Quick that a global fee be introduced (to take effect immediately and to continue until 30th September 2014) for outdoor shooting/target fees. The proposed figure was £10 for Seniors (£5 for Juniors) covering the sixmonth period.

Voting:

Proposal 2: This was favoured by all present at the meeting and a fee was set of £10.00 payable by all Senior club members and £5 for Junior club members covering the period from April to September 2014.


Proposal 1: All members present were in favour of this proposal and so duly accepted to commence on 1st October 2014
